Summary of meeting Minutes of the WFCC&C held on Monday, August 13, 2018

CCTV update – A draft policy document regarding indemnity statements for photo footage from the CCTV cameras has been prepared and will be refined and presented to the next meeting.

Pedestrian Safety on rail bridge, Station Street, Wentworth Falls – WFCC&C are pursuing the matter with Council to resolve what the WFCC&C Inc believe are significant pedestrian and traffic safety issues associated with the Wentworth Falls Rail Bridge

Blue Mountains City Council Public Enquiry - The Commissioner of the enquiry wishes to encourage people who would like to make submissions on matters within the terms of reference of the inquiry to do so in writing.

Lantern On The Lake event - Louise Knox and Camille Walsh gave a report on the previous event in 2016 and asked for support of the WFCC&C for the next event to be held 6th April 2019. Central Blue Mountains Rotary and WFCC&C – WFCC&C to meet with the President of Central Mountains Rotary Ava Edmin to discuss ways in which both organisations can be mutually involved in community activities.

Four Sisters Yulefest Competition - This initiative of Katoomba Chamber of Commerce and Community included the four upper mountain villages of Blackheath, Katoomba, Leura and Wentworth Falls in an attempt to bring more tourists through the towns and villages by decorating the shopfronts and commercial centres in Yuletide fare. 2 shops in Wentworth Falls participated. Hopefully next year more will participate.

Western Sydney Airport update – Major earthworks are set to commence at the WSA site in late 2019. The Northern Road (stage 4) construction is expected to commence in October and conclude early 2021.
